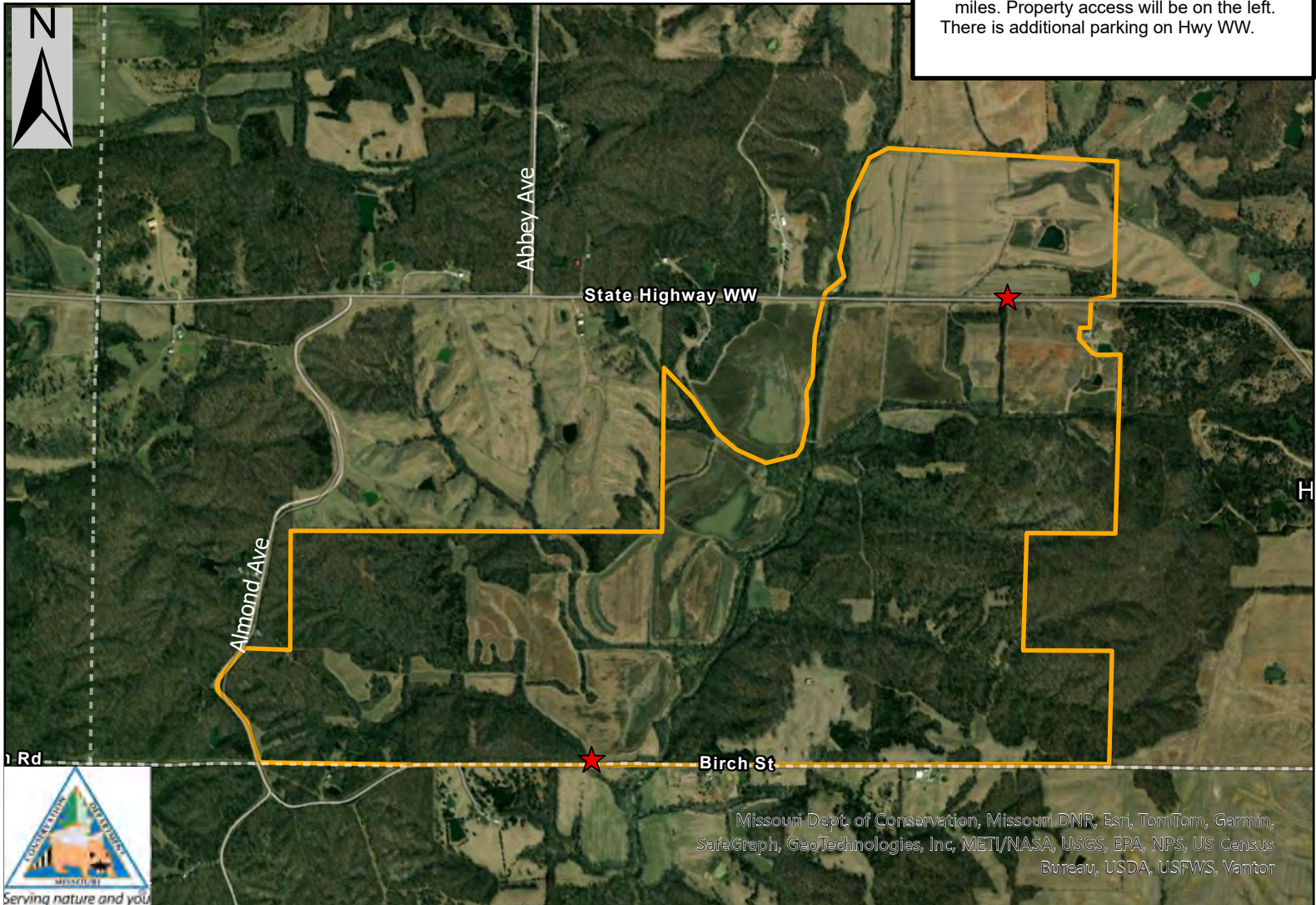
The following small game species may be pursued:

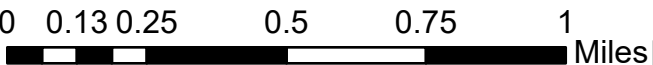
Directions From Marceline:

- 2) Turn south onto Almond Ave; go south 1.3 miles.
- 3) Turn east onto Birch Road. Follow for 0.8 miles. Property access will be on the left. There is additional parking on Hwy WW.
