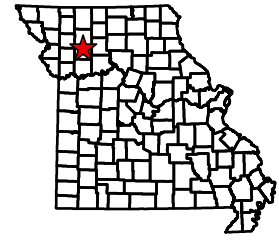

turkey, rabbits, squirrels, quail, pheasant, rails, snipe, doves, woodcock, frogs, and waterfowl.

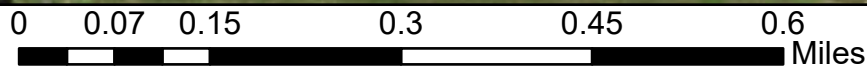
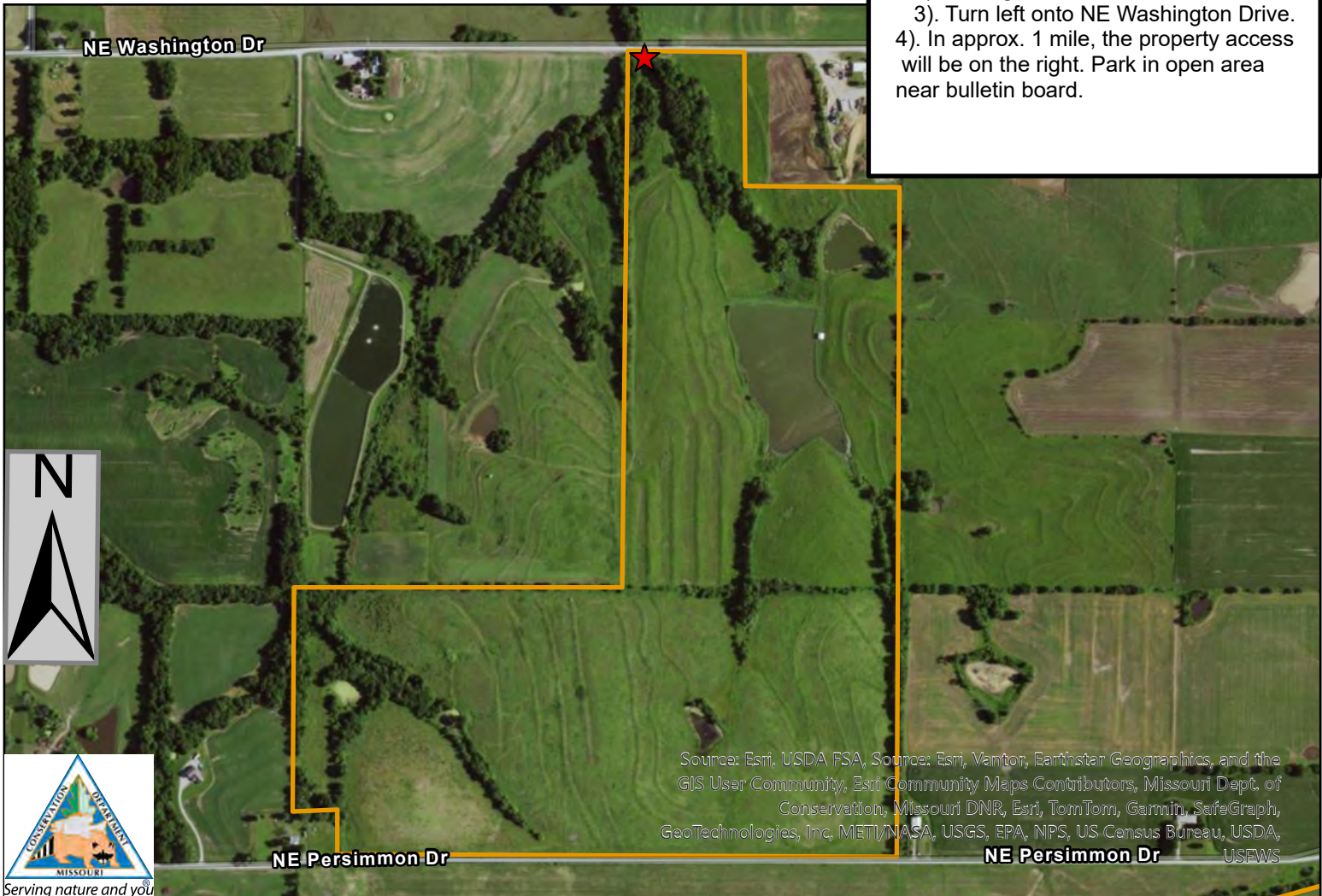
