Rules and Regulations

Conservation areas are closed from 10 p.m. to 4 a.m. except for authorized camping, fishing, and hunting activities.

- No littering.
- No fireworks.
- No open fires.

• Motor vehicles are restricted to roadways and parking areas.

• No free-running pets. Dogs must be leashed or confined when not being used for hunting and training.

• Destroying, cutting or removing vegetation is prohibited. Nuts, berries, fruits, edible wild greens and mushrooms may be taken only for personal consumption.

- No digging or soil disturbance is allowed.
- Horseback riding is not permitted.
- No camping permitted.
- No target shooting allowed.
- Trail and game cameras are prohibited.

Hunting and Trapping

Area is open to hunting and frogging under statewide regulations, except as further restricted by the following regulations:

• Deer and turkey regulations are subject to annual changes. Refer to Spring Turkey or Fall Deer and Turkey booklets for current regulations.

• Only portable tree stands are allowed and only from September 1 through January 31. Unattended stands must be plainly labeled on a durable material with the full name and address, or Conservation Number, of the owner and be removed from the area before February 1. Use of nails, screw-in steps, and any material or method that would damage the tree is prohibited.


