

Area Highlights

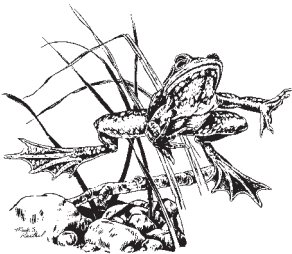
Teszars Woods CA is a 91-acre forested area adjacent to the Meramec River. It is located in the City of Arnold. It is just south of Flamm City Access and adjoins the access through City of Arnold Park property. To reach the area go east of Arnold on Telegraph Road (off of Highway 61/67), then east on Rockwood Drive.

Recreational Opportunities

Bird Watching – Fishing – Hiking
Outdoor Photography – Wildlife Viewing

Conservation Areas are closed from 10 p.m. to 4 a.m. except for authorized fishing and hunting activities.

- No open fires or fireworks.
- Camping is prohibited.
- Bicycling and horseback riding are prohibited.
- Motor vehicles are allowed in parking areas only.
- No target shooting is allowed.
- Dogs must be leashed at all times.
- Nuts, berries, fruits and mushrooms may be taken for personal use. Digging, cutting or removing other vegetation is prohibited.
- No picking, collection, destruction or defacing of any natural objects.
- Hunting is prohibited.



Fishing and Boating

Fishing is permitted under statewide regulations.

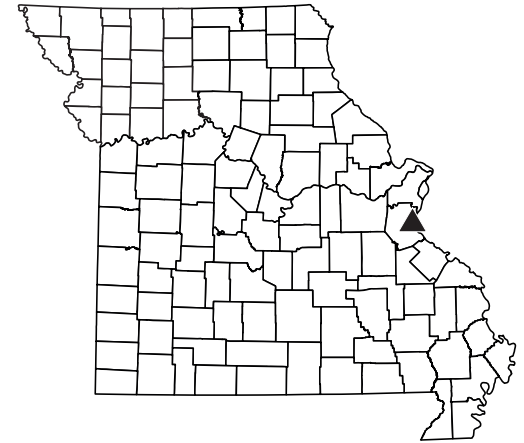
